

## **Appeal Against Admission Form for 2022 Entry for Year 7**

If you decide to appeal against the refusal of a place at Wallington County Grammar School (WCGS), you may lodge an appeal anytime from 1st March 2022 (referred to as National Offer Day). Please complete this form and return it to the school with your supporting documentation. You are asked to supply 5 copies of your form and 5 copies of your supporting documentation, collated into 5 separate packs. We ask for 5 separate collated copies so that the Clerk to the Appeals Panel, each of the 3 Appeals Panel members and the Presenting Officer from the School each have one full copy.

Please send everything to: The Clerk to the Appeals Panel, c/o Wallington County Grammar School, Croydon Road, Wallington, Surrey, SM6 7PH. We would ask that where possible your form and supporting documentation are returned to the School by <u>Tuesday 29th March 2022</u> (which is 20 school days from National Offer Day). By doing so will allow Wallington County Grammar School to hear all of the Transfer to Secondary School lodged appeals on the same day in May/June 2022. Please make every effort to send all documents to support your appeal at the same time, remembering to retain one set for yourself.

The 5 collated packs of your appeal form and any supporting documentation should be **posted or hand** delivered to the School to ensure receipt. The appeal form and any supporting documents cannot be accepted by email.
