University Admissions tests will be taking place here on Wednesday 30th October at 9.00

YOU MUST REGISTER WITH THE EXAMS OFFICER MISS CLODE BY 15TH OCTOBER OTHERWISE YOU CANNOT BE ENTERED

BOTH THE BMAT AND TEST OF MATHEMATICS FOR UNIVERSITY ADMISSION (TMUA) TEST HAVE FEES WHICH NEED TO BE PAID VIA PARENTPAY IF YOU ARE IN Y13. EXTERNAL STUDENTS MUST PAY BY CHEQUE.

Most students will take their University Admissions tests in the **Main Hall**.

If you have exam access arrangements (extra time, laptop, rest breaks) or are taking more than 1 test, you will take your test(s) at the same time but in another venue (still to be decided).

You must bring the following with you:

PHOTO ID – this can be your oyster card, passport or driving licence but the photo must be a recent one.

CLEAR PENCIL CASE – **black** pens, pencils (hb), erasers, highlighters, pencil sharpeners

CALCULATORS – only permitted for section 2 in **ENGAA & NSAA** tests. You must put your calculator on the floor during sections for which calculators are not allowed. Calculators are not permitted in any other admissions test.
